



Washington University Physicians

About 60% of undergraduate students participate in community service.





REVENUES




Total: \$3,543,139,000



Nearly 160,000 alumni, parents, friends, faculty, and staff contributed a record-breaking \$3.378 billion to advance the university's mission of teaching, research, and service. The results of this historic initiative include:

- \$591 million for scholarships to enhance affordability and accessibility for outstanding students
